

Child/ Vulnerable Adult Protection Policy

Version of 4 September 2025

The St Martin's Community Resource Centre aims to ensure that any vulnerable people, whether children, young people or vulnerable adults, are protected and kept safe from harm while they are attending activities within the Centre.

To achieve this we may seek professional references for all tutors/group leaders using the Centre. Additionally, any tutor/group leader running services for unaccompanied children or vulnerable adults, will be required to undergo a Protecting Vulnerable Groups (PVG) check, if they have not already done so. Their tenancy will be agreed only if appropriate evidence of a PVG check is produced or on condition of a satisfactory outcome of this check.

Tutors/ Group leaders are expected to remain within the building until all members of their class or group have left, and to raise any concerns about the safety of any child or vulnerable adult to Social Services.
